

Internationalisation at home



With internationalisation at home, students at Dutch companies develop international competencies. For example, because of working in a foreign language or to be in contact with international suppliers. Is your company internationally oriented? Then make your company visible to students who want to develop international competencies.

Not all mbo students have the opportunity to go abroad during their studies. Internationalisation at home enables them to gain international and intercultural knowledge and skills at Dutch work placement companies. Many professions have an international context. For example, because of the delivery of products and/or services abroad.

Conditions

To be able to offer internationalisation at home, you must meet a number of conditions:

- the student is given the opportunity to speak a modern foreign language (English, German, French or Spanish), this can be in the workplace or with international customers, guests and/or suppliers
- · the workplace is internationally oriented
- the internationally oriented activities ensure the student gains more insight into the world.
